

We have been selected for the EHDEN SME Call#4 tender for the training and certification program of the EHDEN Academy

Upon completion of the training and certification program, our company receives a qualified certificate, with which we will have the opportunity to convert various health data to the observational medical outcomes partnership (OMOP) common data model. This means that for each data source, an Extraction Transform and Load (ETL) process will have to be performed. This contributes to building reliable data sources and data networks.

About the EHDEN project itself:

In response to this, EHDEN (the European Health Data and Evidence Network), was created as a public-private partnership under the framework of the IMI.

EHDEN aspires to be the trusted observational research ecosystem to enable better health decisions, outcomes and **care** for patients across Europe. To achieve this, EHDEN has created a large-scale, federated network of harmonised data sources standardised to the OMOP common data model.
